### Did You Know?

The Bhutan Youth Development Fund, established in 1999, is the oldest non-governmental, civil society organization in Bhutan.

## Background

YDF Fundraising raises awareness and funds for Bhutan Youth Development Fund's programs both at an international and local level. In addition to cultivating donor relations, Fundraising seeks to build a culture of philanthropy and small giving in Bhutan's young civil society.



### Activities

- 1. 250 for Youth: Encouraging small giving of 250 Nu. per month (less than \$5 USD) among a large number of individual Bhutanese donors
- 2. Badum Project: Empowering children under the age of thirteen to save and share with underprivileged Bhutanese youth. Similar to a piggy bank, the earthen pig named Badum is distributed for free and collected to support YDF programs
- 3. Donation Boxes: Encouraging schools, shops, restaurants, and the airport to raise awareness of our impact and encourage small donations to keep it going
- 4. International Advisory Council: Advocating on behalf of Bhutanese youth abroad, advising on YDF's fundraising activities, and expanding YDF's existing international network

### Impact

- Engaged over 1,000 young donors across Bhutan to contribute to YDF programs and initiatives
- Sustains 5% of programs under YDF
